If you wish to make a copy of this PDF file, please do so. If you wish to make a loose leaf binder out of it, we have arranged the pagination so that when you have down-loaded it:

- copy the entire file, each 8 1/2 x 11 page (landscape) back to back with the previous page
- cut each page (8 1/2 x 11) in half & punch it with 3 hole punch, appropriately sized
- if you have trouble centering the pages back to front, when cutting & punching the pages, first hold the pages up to the light and align the type block before proceeding
- manufacture your own, or buy, a 6 x 9 binder from an office supply chain (Staples/Office Depot has the binders for \$5.95)
- do the same for the subject separators (available for \$1.15 [item # AVECI 2095] from above) If neither of these products is in your nearest store, they can be ordered there and it will be mailed to you at the above prices - (if you order over internet, they have a surcharge of \$7.95 for processing!).

This system will give you the opportunity to have a permanent reference book to which annual updates can be added, when they are posted, easily in the correct class and you will be able to keep the handy-bookcase-height-friendly volume at home or in the meetinghouse for ready reference when newcomers come.
